

Planning for the Graham Rodger Tag-Along tour for 2020 is now well and truly underway.

The tour will take you right into the heart of the Australian continent, beginning in the far west of NSW at Broken Hill. Then we head into South Australia with a formal dinner concert in the beautiful historic 1927 Peterborough Town Hall. From there we are heading northwards along the Stuart Highway into the Northern Territory where the final concert and tour end will be in Alice Springs.

Along the way, we will take a detour to the township of Yulara and spend a few days experiencing the wonders of Uluru (Ayres Rock) and Kata Tjuta (The Olgas). We have three days at "The Rock" so you will be able to see the sunrise and sunset on Uluru as well as explore Kata Tjuta at your own pace. (The 3 consecutive days park entry pass costs \$25 per person).

Tag-along tour No.7 is promising to be the best yet! We will be touring through the red centre incorporating places like Broken Hill, Coober Pedy, Uluru and 'The Alice', just some of the major icons of our nation.
